



Adult Engagement Opportunities

24 Hour Generator Facilitator: The role of the facilitator is to guide the team through the idea generation process and come up with a workable solution to the problem presented. The facilitator will be equipped and trained on the CO.STARTERS Canvas, as well as exercises to help the teams work through their ideas over the course of the event. The facilitator will ensure the team completes all required activities and is prepared to pitch by the end of the event. Facilitators are required to be at the entire event, with the exception of sleeping/flex hours and attend a pre-event orientation.

Approximate Time Commitment: Friday Evening 4pm-midnight, Saturday 8am-6pm

Reverse Pitchers: The role of the reverse pitcher is to provide their assigned generator team with a problem to address, using the first three boxes of the CO.STARTERS Canvas as a guide. Reverse pitchers will spend about an hour with their team explaining what their organization does as well as the problem they need solved. The teams will then use this information to develop a workable solution to the problem by the end of the event. Reverse Pitchers are required to attend a pre-event orientation.

Approximate Time Commitment: Friday Evening 5-7pm, Saturday 3-5:30pm (Pitch Presentation)

24-Hour Generator Mentors: The role of the generator mentor is to provide valuable, strategic, periodic feedback to a team in order to help them arrive at the best workable solution possible. We expect mentors to share their experience and expertise with their teams and help nudge them in the right direction. Mentors are expected to spend approximately five hours with their team over the course of the event and attend a pre-event orientation.

Approximate Time Commitment: Friday Evening 5-7pm, Saturday 9-11am

Girls Marketplace Mentors: The role of the marketplace mentor is to provide valuable, strategic guidance of girls ages 8-18 participating in the marketplace in order to help them set-up and run their sales booth throughout the event. We expect mentors to share their experience and expertise with their marketplace vendor to help them run a successful sales booth. Marketplace mentors are expected to spend approximately five hours with their girl vendor to assist with the set-up and execution of their marketplace booth.

Approximate Time Commitment: Saturday 1-4pm

Chaperones: The role of the chaperone is to stay with the students overnight, ensuring their safety and being there to address any needs that arise. Facilitators will most likely go home to get some brief rest before the second day's programming, so chaperones will be in charge to make sure everything goes smoothly throughout the night and breakfast the following morning.

Approximate Time Commitment: Friday 10pm- Saturday 9am
